Today Northern Rivers serves more than 1,400 people each year throughout Saratoga County.

## Behavioral Health Services

- the Behavioral Health Center in Malta is a NYS Office of Mental Health–licensed outpatient counseling facility serving the public
- Unlimited Potential offers vocational rehabilitation and supported employment services for adults in recovery from psychiatric challenges
- School-Based Behavioral Health offices, with 15 offices serving 9 districts, provides NYS Office of Mental Health–licensed outpatient counseling to students in the school building
- Assertive Community Treatment (ACT) provides rehabilitation and support services for residents of Warren and Washington counties who struggle with serious and persistent mental illness
- Home-Based Crisis Intervention provides intensive in-home services for families with children, help them to manage crises, build family relationships, and build life and coping skills

## Community-Based Services

- Prevention and family preservation, intensive programs designed to provide in-home support to keep children safely at home with families
- Health Home Care Management, for children, service coordination and support for those enrolled in a NYS Medicaid Health Home
- Child and Family Treatment and Support Services (CFTSS), provide home and community-based rehabilitative, therapeutic, and peer-driven supports

**Foster Care** provides comprehensive support for foster children, foster parents, and biological family to work toward reunification and permanency goals.

**Residential and Education** programs in Albany and Schenectady provide services to clients in Saratoga, Warren, and Washington Counties.
